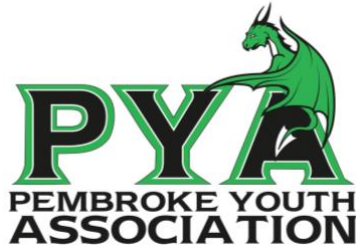

### HS Basketball by Matthew Shay

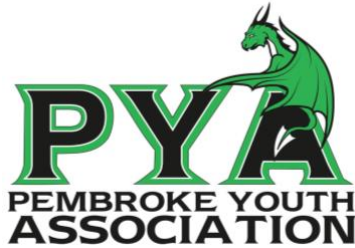
- No report

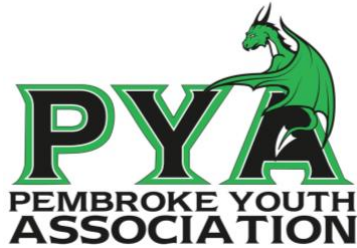
- 29 orders with about \$200 profit
