Meeting Called to Order at 8:14pm, by President, Jasmine Loggins

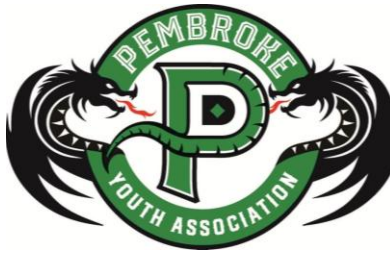
Pledge of Allegiance

- In competition mode until mid-November and going well. Fundraiser made close to \$4,000. Buy new uniforms for pom squad. Winter registration is open.

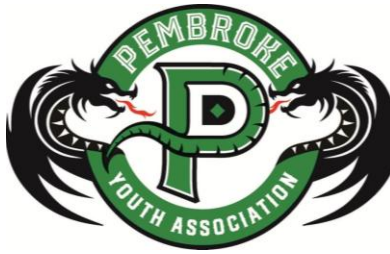
Committee Reports

- Proposed Bylaw: Mergers & Cooperative Agreements
Section Y: Cooperative Agreements and Mergers
 1. Any proposal for a sport program or the Association as a whole to merge, consolidate, or otherwise enter into a cooperative agreement with another district or organization must be initiated and presented by the respective Sport Commissioner.
 2. Such proposals must be brought before the Board of Directors at a regularly scheduled meeting for full discussion and review.
 3. The Board shall evaluate each proposal with consideration to:
 - The needs and best interests of the Association's athletes and families.
 - The impact on the broader community.
 - The long-term sustainability of the Association and the sport program.



4. No merger, cooperative agreement, or consolidation may proceed without a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
5. Financial Considerations:
 - All cooperative agreements or mergers must include clear financial terms that comply with the Association's established financial rules.
 - All revenues and expenses must be properly documented, reported, and approved by the Board.
 - No individual sport or group may independently manage funds outside of the Association's financial policies.
