COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- Enthusiastically support and practice the “Everyone Plays,” “Good Sportsmanship” and “Positive Coaching” philosophies.
- Be reasonable in your demands on a young player's time, energy, enthusiasm, and performance on the field or court.
- Impress on your players they must abide by the rules of the games at all times.
- Develop team respect for the ability of opponents, and for the judgment of referees and opposing coaches.
- Ensure that your players' experience is one of fun and enjoyment (winning is only part of it). Players should never be yelled at or ridiculed for mistakes or losing a game.
- Set a good example and be generous with your praise when it is deserved. Children need a coach they can respect.
- Check equipment, first aid, and playing facilities. They should meet safety standards and be appropriate for the age and ability of your players.
- Follow the advice of a physician when determining when an injured child is ready to play.

COACHES WILL:

- Treat players, parents, and coordinators with respect at all times.
- Not use foul language, hand gestures, or other offensive behavior while at practice, competitions, or games.
- Refrain from physical contact of any kind when taking disciplinary action toward any player.
- Report repeated offenses, problem situations, or potential problems to the Coordinator or PYA Board. This should include, but is not limited to: confrontational parents, guardians, fans, players, other coaching staff, or opposing team members or staff.

Failure to comply with this code or rules of the PYA Organization may result in suspension or other disciplinary action.

If accepted for a coaching position, I hereby agree to abide by the philosophies, and coach's code, the rules and regulations set forth, and the decisions of the Coordinator and PYA Board.
